CFS worker job description:

- To investigate what types of marketing are needed in the targeted area
- Prepare a weekly schedule of activities for the CFS.
- Conduct activity-based life skills sessions, PSS, and recreational activities.
- Identify and refer children with psychosocial problems to the caseworker for management.
- Facilitate monthly meetings with parents to provide updates on the progress of their children and discuss child rights and child protection.
- Prepare and lead sessions from the curriculum daily.
- Supervise and ensure a variety of children's structured play and informal learning activities within the CFS center caters to the needs of children of different ages, genders, and abilities.
- Keep track of children's daily attendance.
- Report any issues to the line manager.
- Monitor the needs and care of children attending the center
- In close collaboration within the CFS, hold regular parents' meetings to keep them informed of any developments or problems within the CFS and surrounding areas.
- Ensure that children's participation and input form the basis of the CFS and the activities.
- Ensure a safe and child-friendly atmosphere within the CFS, that all children feel comfortable, safe, and respected and all children feel included, and no child is discriminated against.
- Establish a rotation system to promote the sharing of equipment and toys between children.
- Be a positive role model and demonstrate conflict-solving behaviors.
- Refer any child with a need for more specialized support to the case worker/ Psychotherapist with explanation.
- Ensure that a child is always not alone in the center/location of activity.
- Always act in the child's best interests.
- Prepare and carry out fun activities for the targeted kids (large events or small groups)
- Determine which kids need additional help or have unique needs within the activity. monitoring each child's participation individually.
- Protective communication with children is important to ensuring that their rights are upheld.



- fulfill the individual and group tasks assigned by her/his supervisors.
- fulfill their responsibility to keep kids safe from abuse and maltreatment of any kind.
- aid in the execution of awareness-raising initiatives for child protection.
- assist in planning collaborative events with young people from the neighborhood.
- Any other duties as may be assigned by the CFS Supervisor or Line Manager, relevant to the achievement of Protection objectives.

Required qualifications:

- University degree in Psychology, Education, social sciences, Refuge and Migrant studies or any other relevant field is highly appreciated
- Minimum of one (1) year experience working with children.
- Proven experience (including volunteer) working with refugees.
- Strong experience in providing recreational activities to children (drama, play, games, circus, sport, storytelling, drawing/painting, artistic activities, music, dancing)
- Excellent communication skills especially with children.
- Computer skills are an added value.
- Basic skills with Arabic language and English.

All applications should be supplied with a PDF CV, detailing a brief description of why the applicant's qualifications and previous work history are suitable for the position.
